Summary:

Last year we brought you Sirtfi, the Security Incident Response Trust Framework for Federated Identity, which lays the foundations for incident response by requiring confidential information exchange and a baseline of good practices in operational security. But, is that enough? What happens when a security incident kicks off? Does your identity federation have plans?

In this lightning talk we will highlight the importance of putting security incident response procedures in place... before they are needed!
